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**Role:** RAG Ambassador

**Department:** Student Activities

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**Opportunity:** As RAG Ambassador, you will be responsible for the organisation, recruitment, development and management of the organised projects, with the opportunity to run your own events as well as be an ambassador for the Students' Union.

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**Benefits:** As a student leader, you will be part of a committee and a wider charitable community which will enhance your communication skills and allow opportunities for networking. We will recognise our RAG Ambassador with certificates, references and CV enhancing opportunities.

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**Duties and responsibilities:** The student leader is responsible for liaising with charities and organisations, volunteers and the Students' Union. The leader is required to represent the interests of their volunteers at monthly meetings and look towards developing the future of student charitable fundraising and volunteering at Bucks. The RAG Ambassador is required to:

- liaise with the two chosen RAG charities, volunteers and the Activities Coordinator (Volunteering & Charity Fundraising)
  - recruit members
  - advertise and attend fundraising events
  - have an overall responsibility for fundraising and RAG successes
  - encourage members of the University to partake in charitable activities.
